TO PRESERVE THE QUALITY OF FISHING ON THE GULLROCK CHAIN OF LAKES, THE POLICY OF THE GULLROCK CAMP OWNERS ASSOCIATION IS THAT ANY WALLEYE OVER 46 CM (18 IN) AND ANY NORTHERN OVER 70 CM (27.5 IN.) CAN ONLY BE TAKEN AS A TROPHY FOR MOUNTING.

**Historical Note**  
Keg Lake gets its name from the story of a group of traders being pursued by a war party approaching from the north. The swift canoes of the war party soon caught up to the traders south of Red Lake. Upon seeing the Indians the traders threw their kegs of trade rum, (a most valuable commodity) into the lake thus lightening their load and escaping the war party.
